Foreword

In this publication all references to our Creator are used as in the original Hebrew text of the **TaNaKh**, an acronym for Torah, Nevi'im and Ketuvim, meaning the Law, Prophets and Writings. Our Heavenly father is therefore referred to as YHWH (the transliteration for His Name, Yod-Heh-Waw-Heh, and His title, Elohim, meaning the Mighty One.

Personal, place names and general terms used in this publication are adapted from The Scriptures (TS2009) published by Institute for Scripture Research. Special characters are however simplified to make it understandable for children.

We suggest you consult the index pages of The Scriptures (TS2009) for the names of the books of Scripture, giving both the Hebrew names and Anglicised names. However, in this publication, teaching the Hebrew roots of the belief, the Hebrew names were retained.

Names containing the Hebrew letter 'beyt' have been rendered as a 'v' (veyt), where they express the soft pronunciation of the letter.

Similarly the Hebrew letter 'chet' has been rendered 'ch' such as **Chaw-wah**, **Noach** etc.

YHWH CALLS AVRAM

In a land called Ur-Kasdim there lived a man named Terach. He was one of the descendants of Noach's son, Shem. Terach had three sons. Their names were Avram, Nachor and Haran.

When Haran had children, he named them Lot, Milka and Yiskah. Haran died before his father, Terach. His daughter, Milka, married her uncle Nachor. Avram married Sarai. She was barren and did not have children.

Terach and his grandson, Lot, left Ur-chasdim with Avram and Sarai, to go to a land called Kena'an. They travelled as far as Charan and stayed there. When Terach was two hundred and five years old, he died in Charan.

And YHWH said to Avram "Leave your land, your relatives and your father's house, and go to a land which I will show you. And I shall make you a great nation, and bless you, and make your name great, and you shall be a blessing.

And I shall bless those who bless you and curse him who curses you. And in you all the clans of the earth shall be blessed."

Avram obeyed YHWH. He was seventy-five years old when he, his wife Sarai and his nephew, Lot, took all their possessions and left Charan.

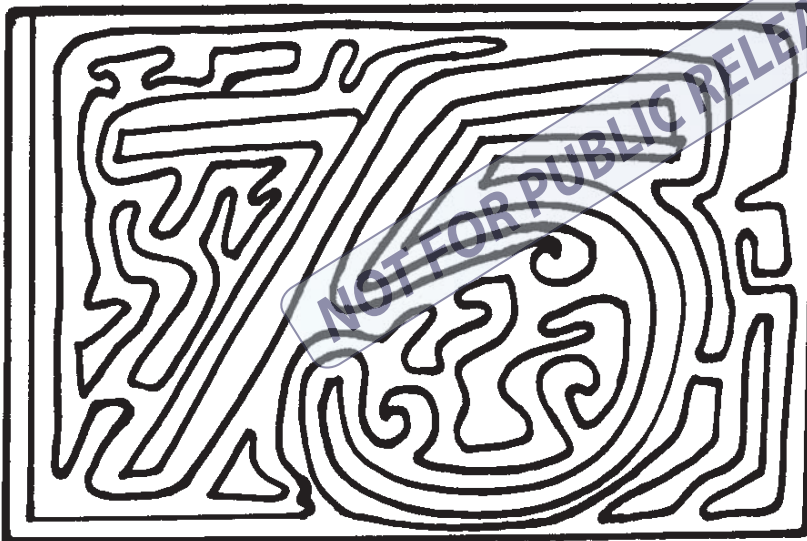
They arrived at Kena'an where the Kena'anites lived. They travelled through the land until they reached the Terebinth tree of Moreh at Shechem. While they lived there, YHWH appeared to Avram and said to him: "I give this land to your descendants."

Then Avram built a slaughter place there, to YHWH, who appeared to him.

From there, they travelled to the mountain east of Beyth El. They pitched their tent there, between Beyth El on the west and Ai on the east. Avram built a slaughter place to YHWH and called on the Name of YHWH.

They kept travelling south, but there was a severe scarcity of food in the land, so they decided to go to Mitsrayim.

Avram obeyed YHWH. How old was he when he left Charan? Find his age in the picture and colour it blue.



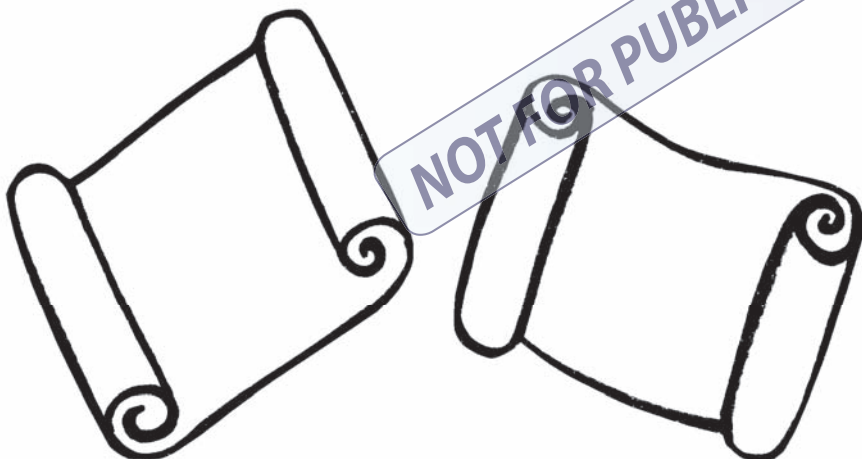

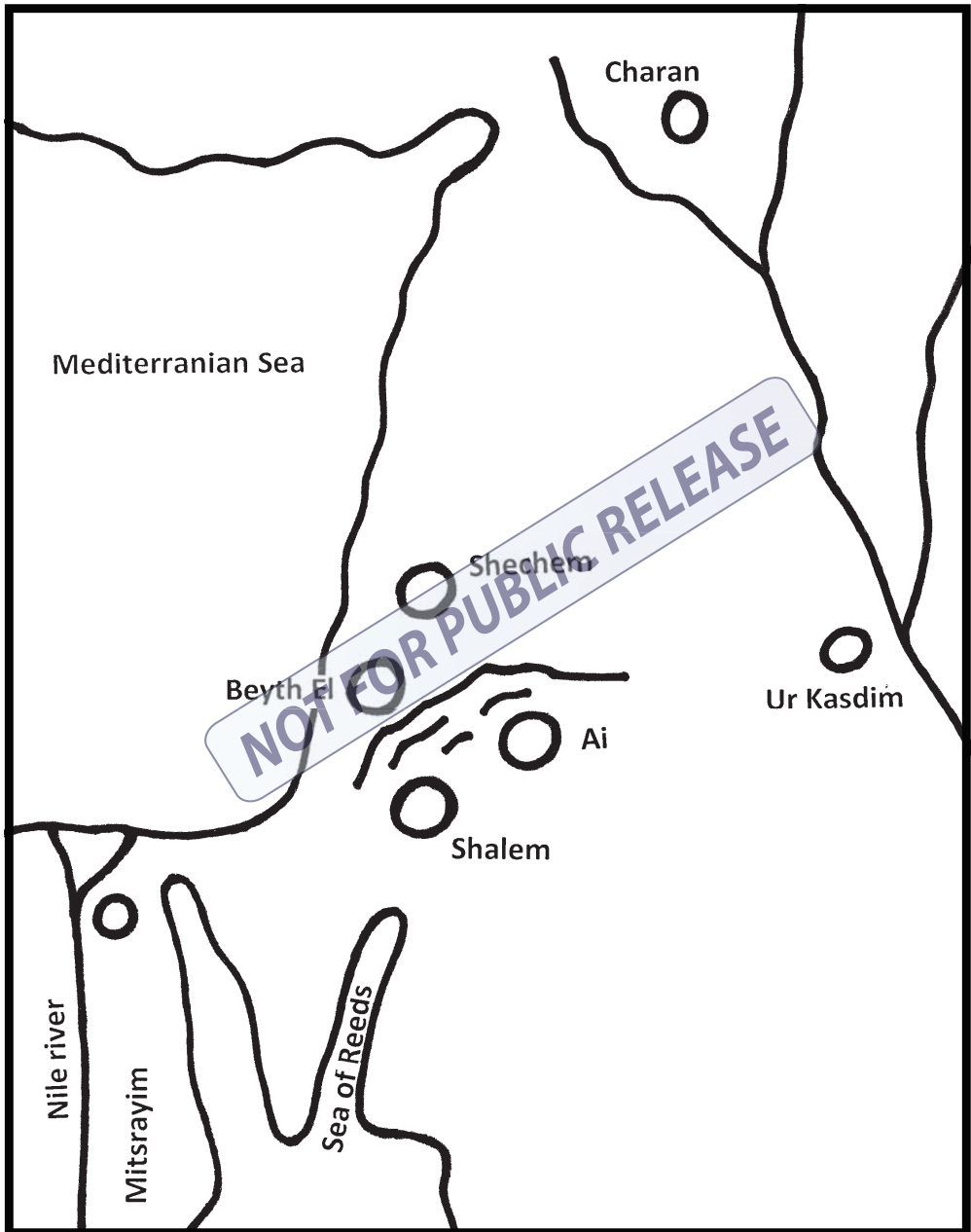

AVRAM AND SARAI IN MITSRAYIM

When they came close to the border of Mitsrayim, Avram said to his wife Sarai: "You are very beautiful. When the Mitsrians see you, they will say, 'This is his wife' and they will kill me, but let you live. Please tell them that you are my sister. Then they will let me live and they will treat me well for your sake."

When they entered Mitsrayim, the Mitsrians saw that Sarai was very beautiful and they took her to Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh was pleased and treated Avram well. He gave him sheep, cattle, donkeys, camels and servants.

But YHWH sent great plagues over Pharaoh and the people in his house because he took Avram's wife.

Then Pharaoh called Avram and said to him: "What have you done to me? Why didn't you tell me that she was your wife? Why did you say, 'She is my sister'? I was going to take her as my wife!

Here is your wife. Take her and leave." Then Pharaoh gave orders to his men to send Avram and Sarai away with all their possessions.

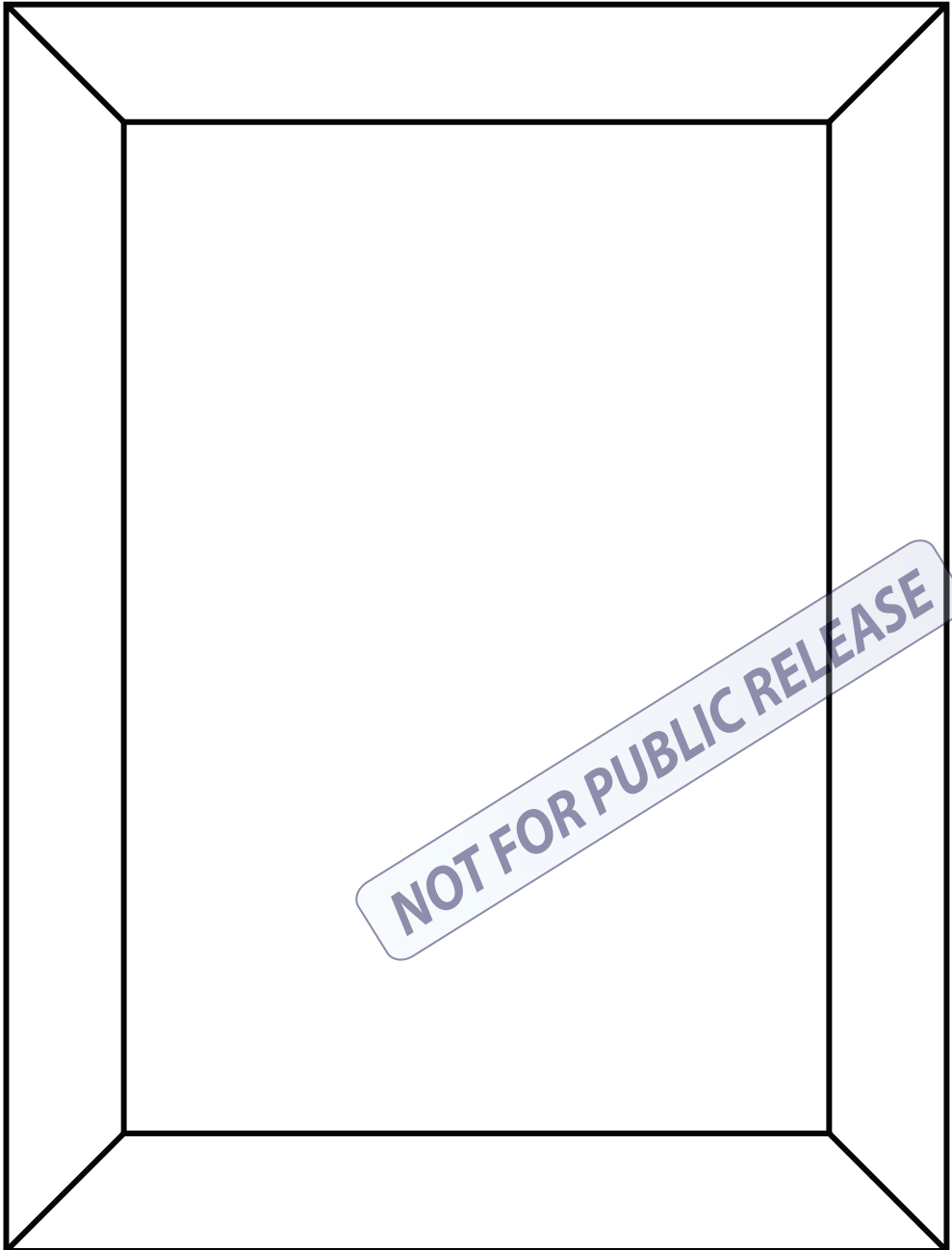

A PROMISE TO AVRAM

Avram was a very rich man who had many sheep, goats, camels and other livestock as well as lots of silver and gold.

Avram, Sarai and Lot took all their belongings and left Mitsrayim. They went back to the place where they stayed before, between Beyth El and Ai, where Avram had built an altar to YHWH before. There Avram called on the Name of YHWH.

Lot also had flocks and herds and tents, so there was not enough space for them to live together. Because they did not have enough pasture land for all the livestock, quarrels broke out between the shepherds of Avram and the men who took care of Lot's animals.

Then Avram said to lot: "We are brothers and your men and my men should not be quarrelling. Please move away from me. Choose any part of the land and I will take the opposite side. If you choose the left side, I will take the right side, and if you choose the right side, I will take the left."

Lot looked around and saw that the Yarden valley had much water everywhere, like the garden of YHWH and like Mitsrayim. So he chose to take the whole Yarden valley for himself, while Avram stayed in Kena'an.

Lot went to live among the cities in the valley. He pitched his tent near Sedom, where the people were wicked and sinned against YHWH.

After Lot left, YHWH said to Avram: "Look in all directions. Look to the north and to the south, to the east and to the west. All the land you see, I will give to you and to your descendants forever.

I will give you so many descendants that no one will be able to count them all. They will be as the dust of the earth. If a man could count the dust of the earth, then your descendants could also be counted.

Get up and walk through the length and the width of the land, because I am giving it to you."

So Avram moved his tent and went to live in Chevron, by the Terebinth trees of Mamre where he built a slaughter place to YHWH.

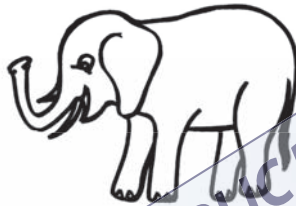

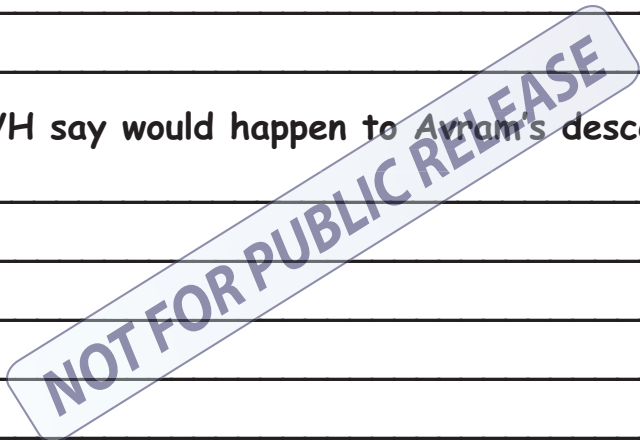

THE SIGN OF THE COVENANT

When Avram was ninety-nine years old, YHWH appeared to him and said: "I am El Shaddai (The Almighty). Walk before Me and be perfect and I will make a covenant with you and give you many descendants."

Then Avram bowed down low with his face to the ground and YHWH said to him: "I make this covenant with you: 'I will give you so many descendants, that they will form nations. Your name will no longer be Avram, but you will be called Avraham, because I will make you the father of many nations. Some of your descendants will become sovereigns (kings).

This covenant will be between Me and you and all your descendants after you, forever. I will be your Elohim (Mighty One) and the Elohim of your descendants.

I will give this land where you are living now, to you and them. The whole land of Kena'an will belong to you and your descendants forever. And I shall be their Elohim.

You and your descendants must guard my covenant with you forever.

From now on, you must circumcise every baby boy when he

is eight days old. Even the sons of your slaves must be circumcised. This is the sign of the covenant between us.

If a son is not circumcised, he has broken my covenant and he will no longer be seen as one of My people.”

Elohim also said to Avram: “You must no longer call your wife Sarai. From now on her name is Sarah.

I will bless her and I will give you and Sarah a son. Nations and sovereigns will come from her.”



Then Avraham bowed down low with his face to the ground and laughed, thinking to himself: “Can a man have a child when he is a hundred years old? Can Sarah have a baby at ninety?” And Avraham said to Elohim: “Oh let Yishma’el live before you!”

But Elohim said to him: "No, your wife Sarah will have a baby boy and you must call him Yitschaq. My covenant will be with him and his descendants forever.

I have also heard your request for Yishma'el. I shall also bless him and give him many descendants. He will become the father of twelve princes and his descendants will become a great nation. But my covenant is with Yitschaq, the son you and Sarah will have this time next year."

When He finished speaking to Avraham, He left. Then Avraham circumcised his son Yishma'el and all the other males in his household, as Elohim commanded him. Avraham was ninety-nine years old and Yishma'el was thirteen when they were circumcised on that same day.

Sarah became afraid so she denied it and said: "I did not laugh." But He said to her, "No, you did laugh."

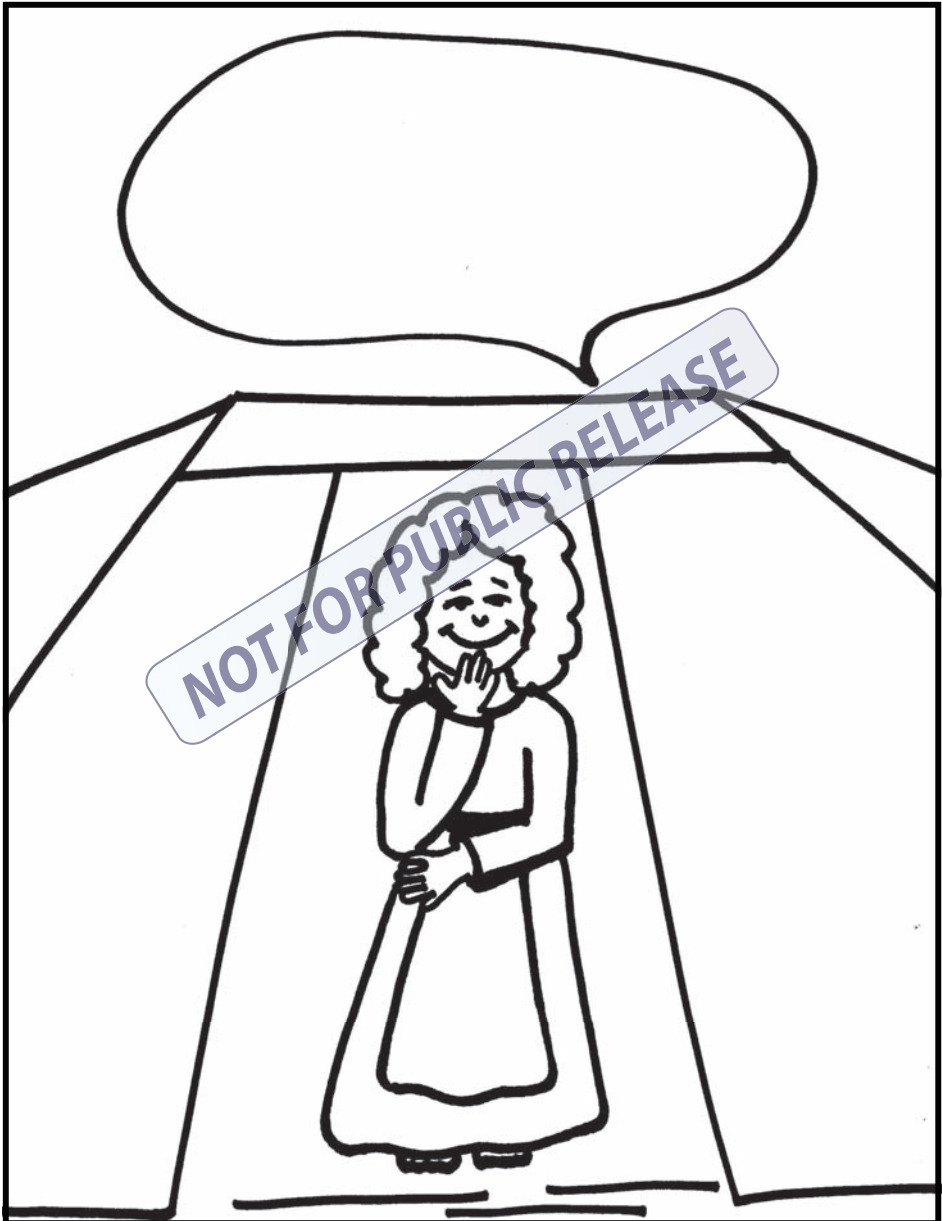

HOW TO PLAY THE GAME

1. You will need:

- dice
- a different colour or shape token or button for each player

2. Who begins?

- Take turns, clockwise, to roll the dice.
- The player with the highest score starts the game.

3. Playing the game:

- The player with the highest score starts.
- Roll the dice.
- Move your token by the amount on the dice.
- Follow the instructions on the square you land on.

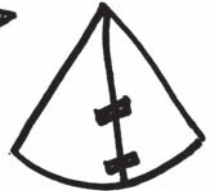

5. Put the tent on a sheet of green or brown cardboard.

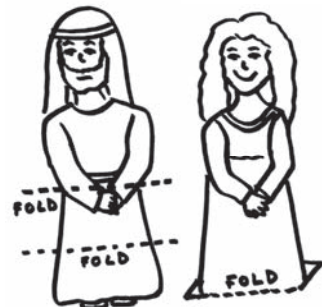
6. Colour the rectangle and fold slightly to form a chair for Avraham.

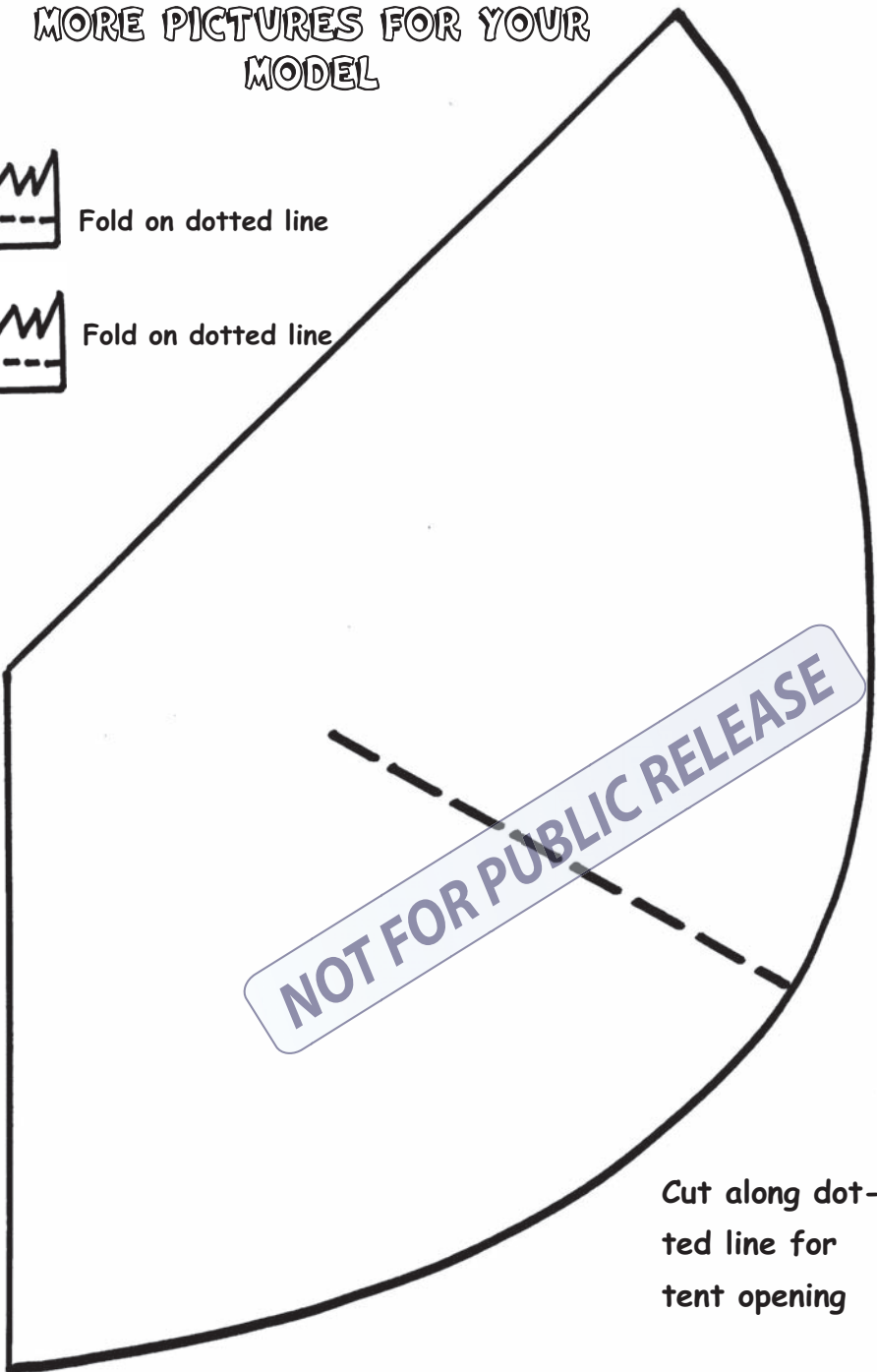

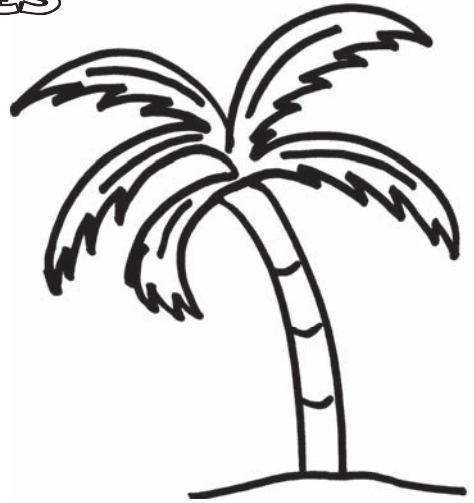

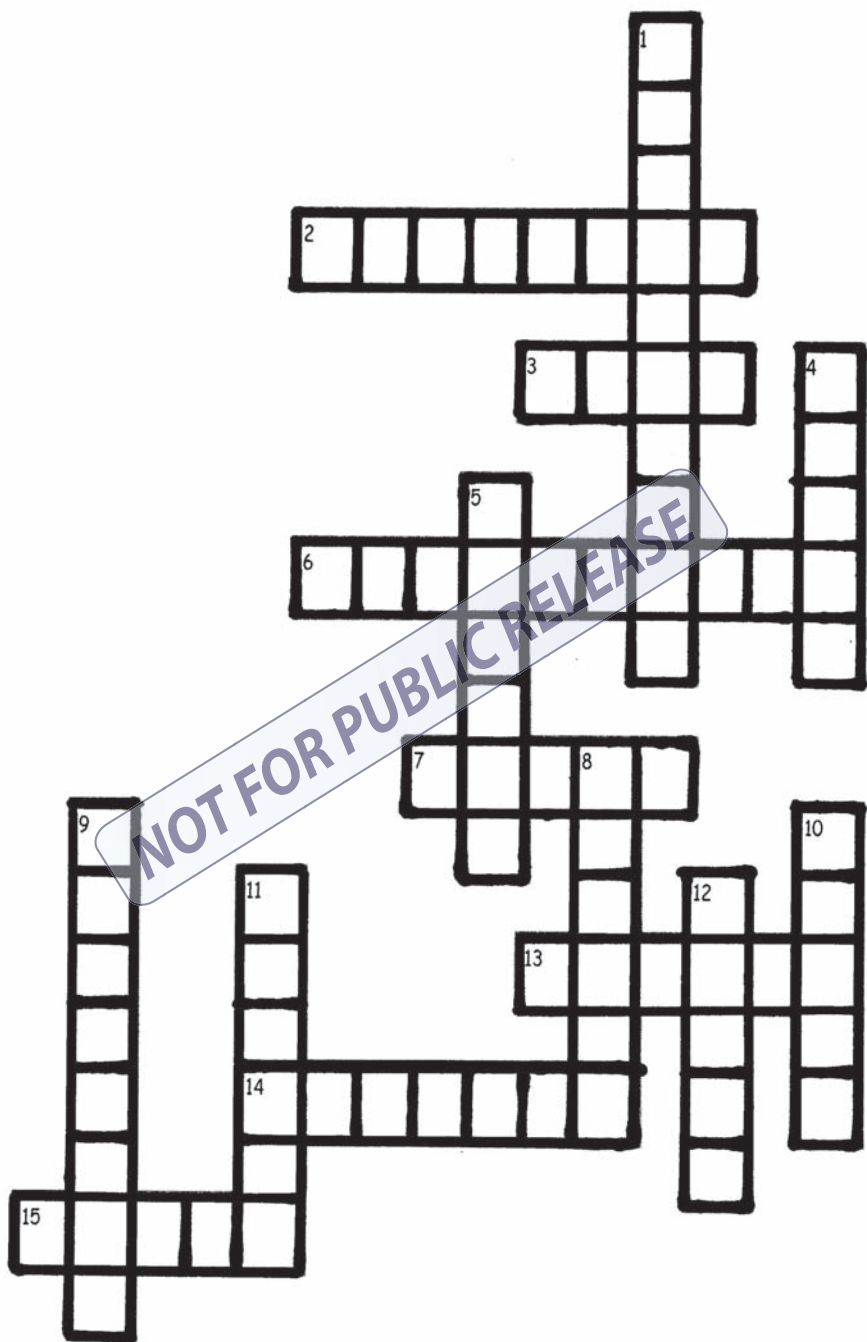

AVRAHAM PLEADS FOR SEDOM

After Avraham's visitors had eaten, they looked toward Sedom and prepared to leave. Avraham walked with them some distance and YHWH said: "Avraham is certainly going to become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him. Shall I hide from him what I am about to do? I know him. He commands his children and his family to obey YHWH. He teaches them to do what is right."

Then YHWH said: "There is a great outcry against Sedom and Amorah because of their sin. I am going there now to see if they are guilty or not."

The men left and went toward Sedom, but YHWH stayed with Avraham.

Avraham came closer and said: "Will You destroy the righteous people with the guilty ones? Suppose there are fifty righteous people in the city. Would You not spare the city for them? Do not consider killing the righteous with the guilty. Should the judge of all the earth not do right?"

"If I find fifty righteous people in Sedom, I will spare the city for their sakes," YHWH answered.

Then Avraham said: "Look, please, I who am only dust and ashes have taken it upon myself to speak to YHWH.

Suppose there are forty-five righteous, would you destroy the whole city because there are five short?"

And YHWH answered: "If I find forty-five there, I will spare the city."

"What if You find forty?" Avraham asked.

"I will not do it if I find forty," He answered.

"Please do not be angry if I speak again," Avraham said.

"What if there are thirty?"

And YHWH answered: "I will not do it if there are thirty."

SEDOM AND AMORAH

The two messengers left Avraham and arrived at Sedom in the evening. Lot, who was sitting at the gate of the city, saw them and he stood up to meet them. 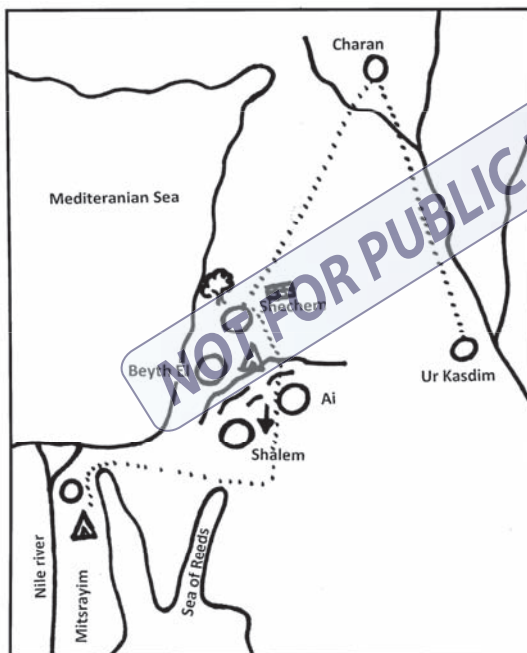

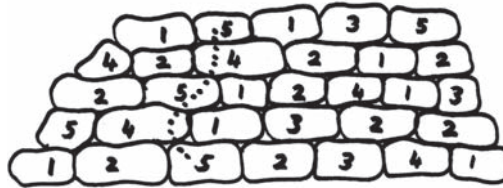
